FOCUS STATEMENT

Helping to grow a thriving economy in North Minneapolis by supporting entrepreneurs, small businesses and expanding local ownership opportunities.

PURPOSE

The Northside Commercial Real Estate Advisory Committee of The Jay and Rose Phillips Family Foundation of Minnesota is allocating \$100,000 in grants to support pre-development soft costs for Black real estate developers with site control of commercial properties in North Minneapolis. The purpose of these grants is to alleviate smaller financial burdens that often hinder the success and sustainability of developers from a historically marginalized community with limited representation in the real estate development field. Thanks to funding provided by The Jay and Rose Phillips Family Foundation of Minnesota, \$100,000 will be distributed to projects in North Minneapolis, prioritizing neighborhoods connected to the West Broadway corridor and other transit corridors in the area. These neighborhoods include: Cleveland, Harrison, Hawthorne, Jordan, McKinley, Near North, Sumner-Glenwood, Victory, Willard-Hay, and Webber-Camden. Priority will also be given to applicants who are North Minneapolis residents, and to projects with universal design or sustainability attributes.

GUIDELINES

What We Will Fund

Grants are available for pre-development soft costs for commercial or "missing middle" (5-unit minimum) residential real estate projects. These funds may also be used as matching funds for other funding opportunities.

Ineligible Expenses:

Who Is Eligible to Apply?

Grant funds have been established to support Black real estate developers with site control of commercial or "missing middle" (5-unit minimum) residential real estate projects located in North Minneapolis. Projects must be in neighborhoods connected to the West Broadway corridor or other transit corridors in the area (see the neighborhood list below).

Applicants who have already received funding through this opportunity are not eligible to apply for funding for the same project. Priority will be given to first-time applicants. Priority will also be given to applicants who are North Minneapolis residents, and to projects that incorporate universal design or sustainability attributes.
